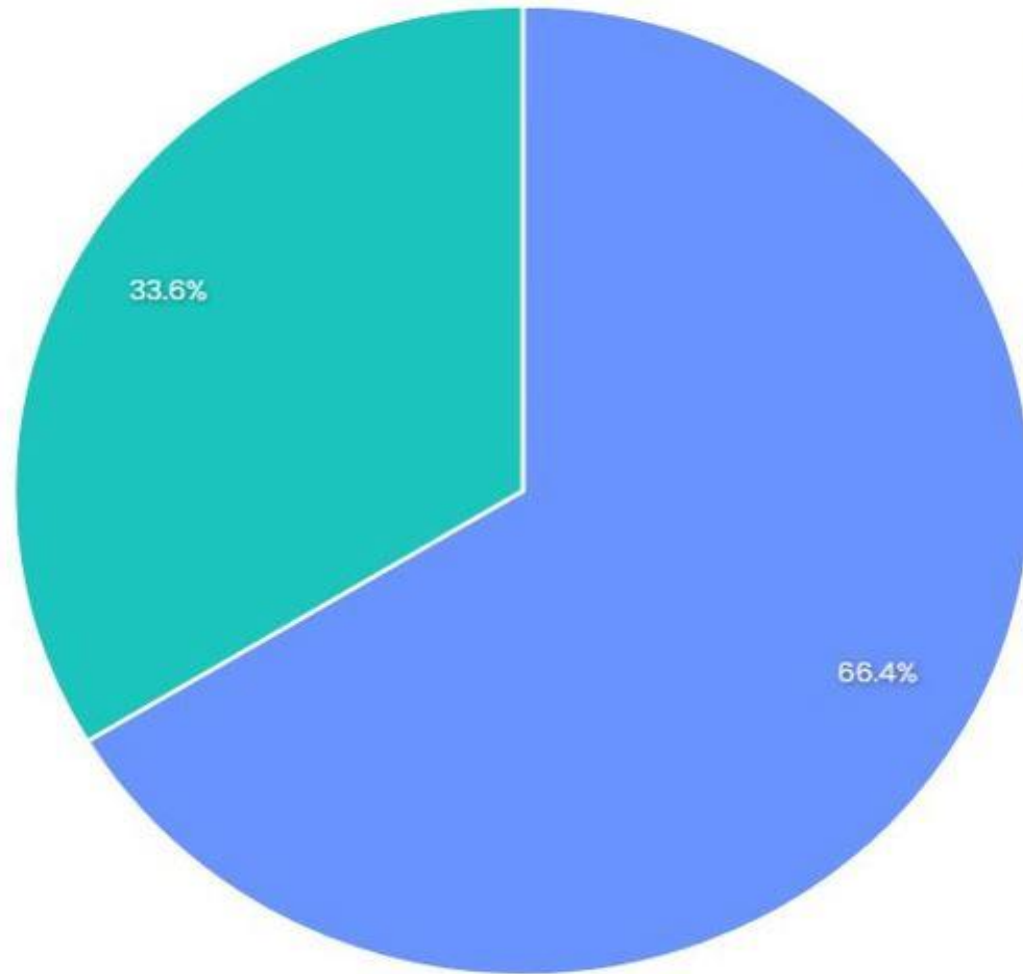

DISTRIBUTION TO FOREST RESERVES

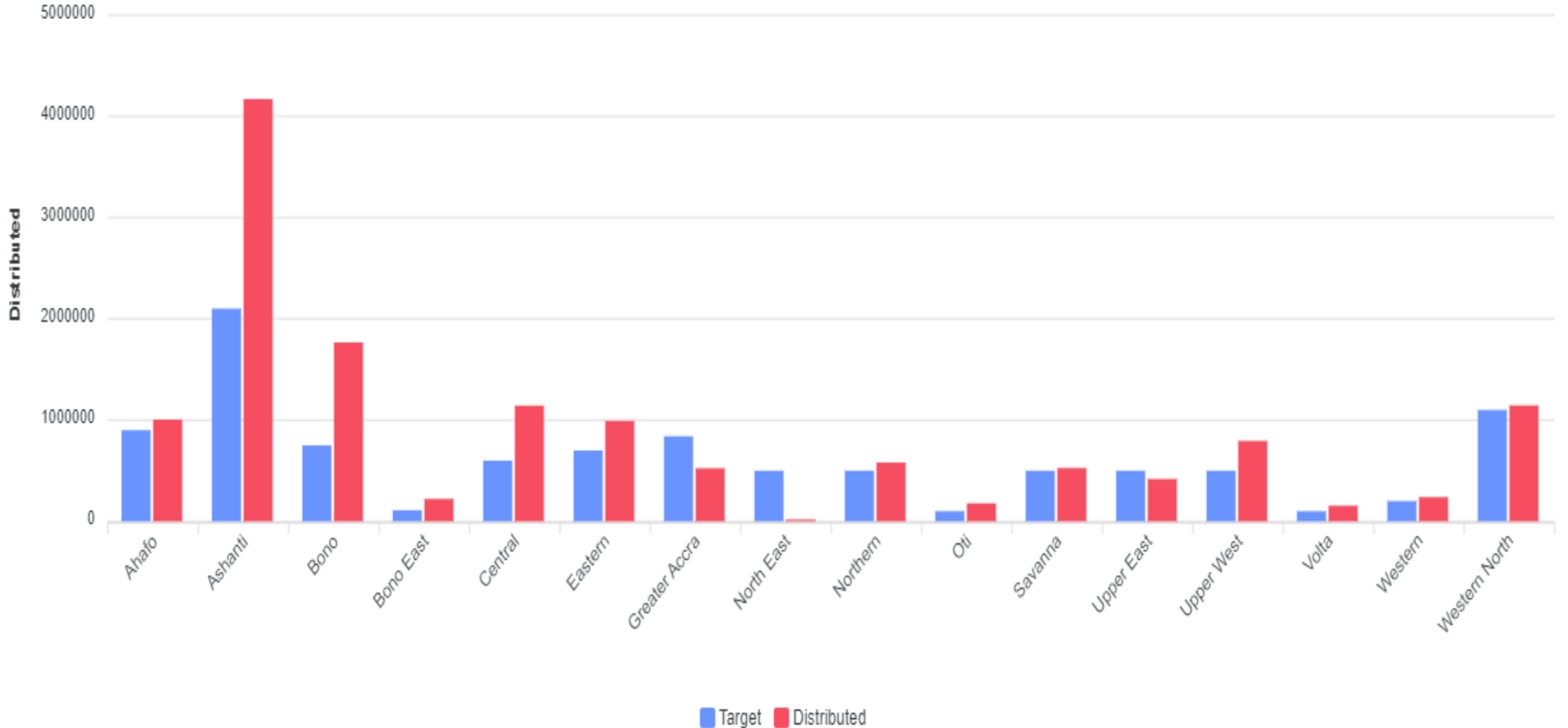

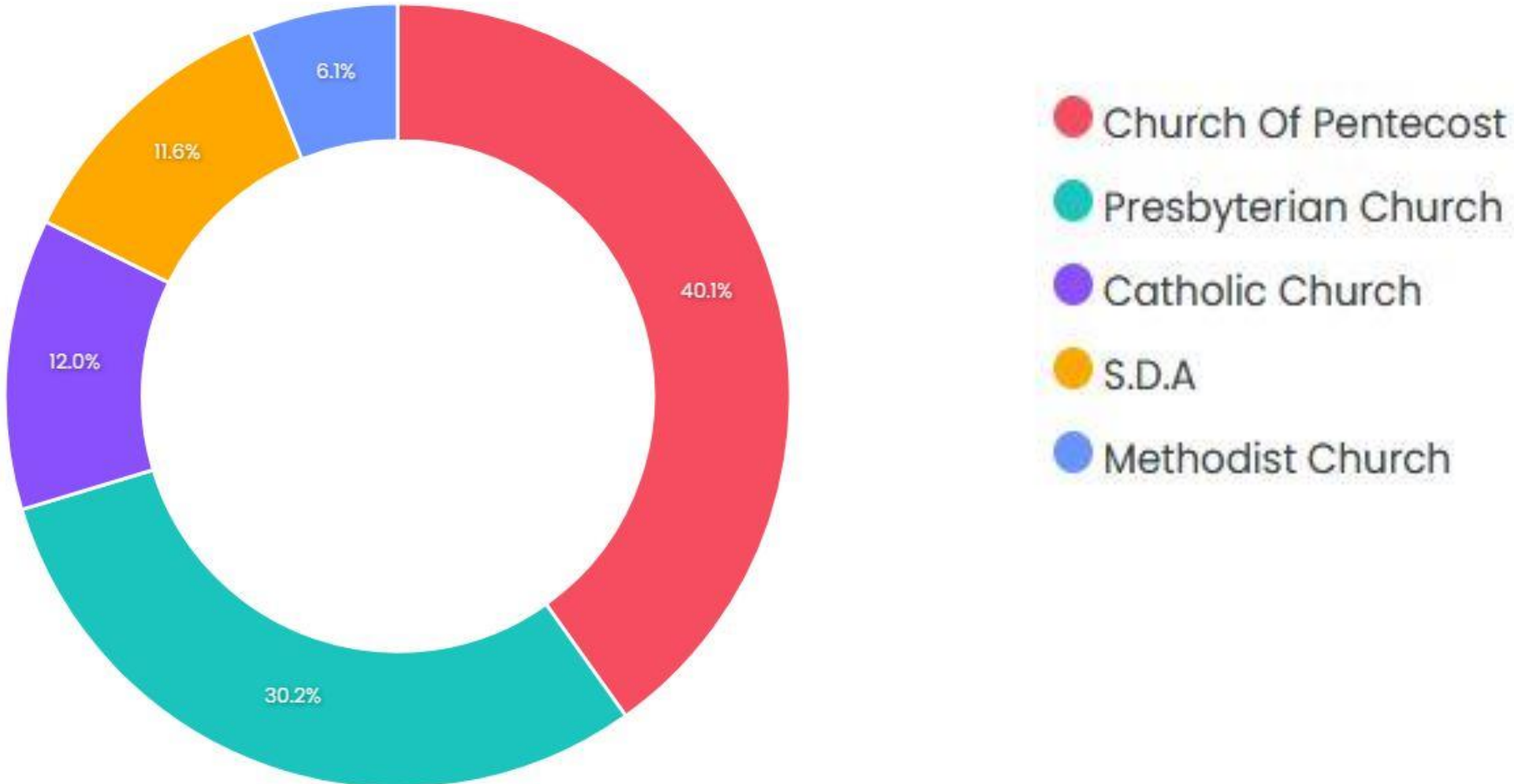
